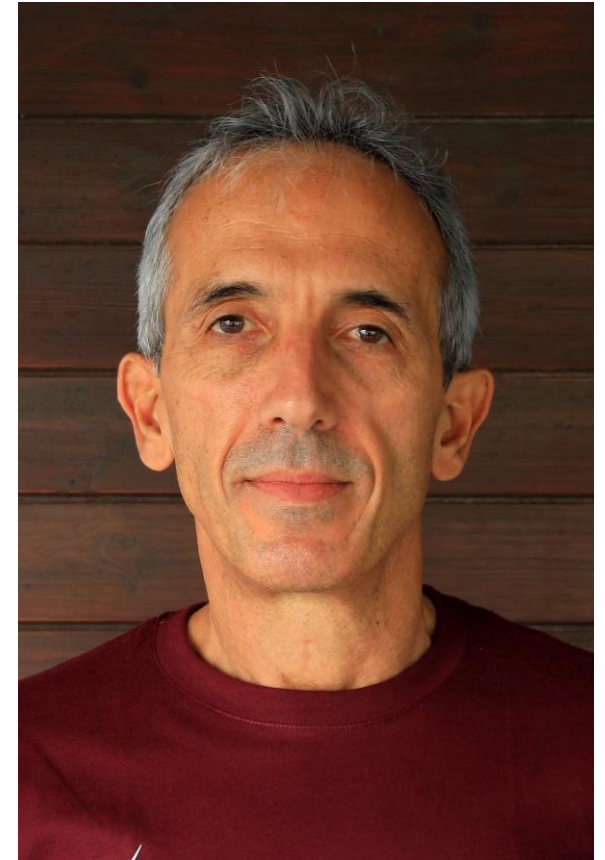
Christodoulos (Lakis) ANASTASIOU
